

# 1948 Rolls-Royce Silver Wraith

## Four Seat Limousine - Coachwork by H.J. Mulliner



This Rolls-Royce limousine was owned from new by Mr. F. Smith, proprietor of Smiths Crisps, prior to being used by the Nigerian Embassy in London. Since the 1960s, this vehicle has been part of a museum collection in the U.S.A. accounting for its true recorded mileage of 48,000 miles.

Now completely re-trimmed in ivory leather, the rear compartment offers exceptionally luxurious and roomy accommodation, with an electrically operated division separating the chauffeur from the passengers.
